Pet Pantry Enrollment Form

The Fredericksburg Regional SPCA Pet Pantry offers temporary assistance to help pet parents feed their beloved animals in times of financial hardship. The pantry does NOT provide food for anyone breeding or selling animals and reserves the right to refuse anyone under any circumstances. Below you will find some general guidelines, however each request is reviewed individually. Please note that supplies are given on a once per month basis. This assistance is meant to be supplemental, and is not intended to feed your pet(s) for an entire month.

For each additional person in the household above 8, add \$14,000

- Recipients must be 18 years old or older.
- All pet food supplies are donated, and we may not have the exact brand your pet is used to, which may cause stomach upset.
- Agree not to hold Fredericksburg SPCA Pantry, volunteers, staff and benefactors legally liable in the unfortunate event that your pet becomes ill or the food upsets your pet(s) stomach.
- We will do the best we can to accommodate special requests, but we are only able to give what is available to us at the time.
- Proof of current vaccinations and spay/neuter for each enrolled animal is required within 6 months of enrollment. The PETS Program can help pet owners facilitate veterinary care for their pet(s) - please email <u>PETS@fredspca.org</u> for assistance.
