



Virginia Veteran and Family Support (VVFS) provides outreach, connection and support to veterans and their families as they address the challenges of military service, transition, deployments, PTS and behavioral health concerns, physical and traumatic brain injuries. Referral and connection services are coordinated with community services boards, brain injury service providers, VA medical facilities and other public and private agencies. Additionally, VVFS provides direct support via personalized care coordination, peer to peer mentoring, caregiver skill building and support groups.

The VVFS Justice Involved Services (JIS) program offers support to veterans and service members involved in the criminal justice system. The program provides direct services t justice-involved veterans and service members interfacing with courts and diversion/veteran docket programs, during incarceration in jails and prisons, and upon re-entry to the community. A Veteran Justice Specialist identifies needs, develops a coordinated service plan, and connects the veteran/service membe
